I am requesting funding for the City of Alexandria, Virginia's "On-route Electric Transit Bus Opportunity Chargers" project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Alexandria, VA, located at 301 King Street, Alexandria, VA 22314. The funding would be used to fund the construction and implementation of up to two on-route opportunity fast chargers within the City of Alexandria.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the funds would support charging requirements of a full 100% Zero Emissions Battery Electric transit bus fleet.
