3	(a) In General.—Section 6320 of title 38, United
4	States Code, is amended, in subsection (a)—
5	(1) in paragraph (1), by inserting "members of
6	the Armed Forces described in subsection (b) and"
7	after "needs of"; and
8	(2) in paragraph (2)—
9	(A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
10	(A)—
11	(i) by inserting "with the Department
12	of Defense" after "coordinate efforts"; and
13	(ii) by inserting "such members of the
14	Armed Forces and" after "to assist";
15	(B) in subparagraph (A), by inserting
16	"such members and" after "reach out to"; and
17	(C) in subparagraph (B), by inserting
18	"such members and" after "to connect".
19	(b) Activities of the Solid Start Program.—
20	Such section is further amended, in subsection (b)(1)—
21	(1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting "(with
22	priority for members between during the period be-
23	tween 120 and 210 days before separation)" after
24	"separating from the Armed Forces";
25	(2) in subparagraph (D), by inserting "such

9	compiling and filing the member's claim
10	for disability compensation;

16	"(ii) if calling a member under such sub-
17	paragraph has not resulted in contact before ex-
18	ceeding the maximum number of call attempts
19	as the Secretary may specify:".
