
This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will increase economic growth and enhance community connections for residents of all ages through the renovation and reuse of an old high school into a center that will be used for workforce development programming. The jobs that participants will be prepared for are in high-demand fields where there are labor shortages, including health care and trade professions. This not only benefits individuals, but the entire community as it will ultimately increase access to these services for all residents.

The project will support the construction of workforce development and youth reengagement programming spaces. It will include the construction of a medical skills laboratory classroom, administered by the Northern Virginia Community College, for residents to obtain medical certifications in high-demand health care fields. There will also be classrooms and workshop space for residents to become certified in trades like HVAC and plumbing. In addition, a youth reengagement center will be constructed to offer a workforce training program, providing a continuum of services and supports to boost the economic mobility and social capital among at-risk youth.

This project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305 (a)(2) and 42 U.S.C. 5305 (a)(4).
