A BILL

To establish a National Secure Data Service, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "National Secure Data5 Service Act".

6 SEC. 2. NATIONAL SECURE DATA SERVICE.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Director, in consultation with
8 the Chief Statistician of the United States, shall establish
9 a demonstration project to develop, refine and test models

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to inform the full implementation of the Commission on
 Evidence-Based Policymaking recommendation for a gov ernment-wide data linkage and access infrastructure for
 statistical activities conducted for statistical purposes, as
 defined in chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code.

6 (b) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than one year after
7 the date of enactment of this Act, the Director shall estab8 lish a National Secure Data Service demonstration
9 project. The National Secure Data Service demonstration
10 project shall be—

(1) aligned with the principles, best practices,
and priority actions recommended by the Advisory
Committee on Data for Evidence Building, to the extent feasible; and

(2) operated directly by or via a contract that
is managed by the National Center for Science and
Engineering Statistics.

(c) DATA.—In carrying out this subsection, the Director shall engage with State and federal agencies to collect, acquire, analyze, report, and disseminate statistical
data in the United States and other nations to support
governmentwide evidence-building activities consistent
with the Foundations for Evidence-Based Policymaking
Act of 2018.

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1 (d) PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY PROTEC-TIONS.—If the Director issues a management contract 2 3 under subsection (b), the awardee shall be designated as an "agent" under chapter 35 of title 44, United States 4 5 Code Subchapter III, section 3561 et seq., with all requirements and obligations for protecting confidential in-6 7 formation delineated in the Confidential Information Pro-8 tection and Statistical Efficiency Act of 2018 and the Pri-9 vacy Act of 1974.

10 (e) TECHNOLOGY.—In carrying out this subsection, the Director shall consider application and use of systems 11 and technologies that incorporate protection measures to 12 13 reasonably ensure confidential data and statistical products are protected in accordance with obligations under 14 15 chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code, subchapter III, section 3561 et seq., including systems and technologies 16 that ensure raw data and other sensitive inputs are not 17 18 accessible to recipients of statistical outputs from the National Secure Data Service demonstration project. 19

20 (f) TRANSPARENCY.—The National Secure Data
21 Service established under subsection (b) shall maintain a
22 public website with up-to-date information on supported
23 projects.

24 (g) REPORT.—Not later than 2 years after the date25 of enactment of this Act, the National Secure Data Serv-

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ice demonstration project established under subsection (b) 1 2 shall submit a report to Congress that includes— 3 (1) a description of policies for protecting data, 4 consistent with applicable Federal law; 5 (2) a comprehensive description of all completed 6 or active data linkage activities and projects; 7 (3) an assessment of the effectiveness of the demonstration project for mitigating risks and re-8 9 moving barriers to a sustained implementation of 10 the National Secure Data Service as recommended 11 by the Commission on Evidence-Based Policy-12 making; and 13 (4) if deemed effective by the Director, a plan 14 for scaling up the demonstration project to facilitate 15 data access for evidence building while ensuring 16 transparency and privacy. 17 (h) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There are authorized to be appropriated to the Director to carry 18 19 out this subsection \$56,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2022 through 2026. 20
