
Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for “Violence and Crime Prevention Technology within the City of Alexandria” in fiscal year 2025. This request is for funding to support enhanced technology and data management for the Alexandria Police Department, including In-Car Cameras, Public Safety Cameras, and an operating system to manage these resources. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this funding will assist Alexandria’s law enforcement agency to leverage advanced technologies to enhance public safety, operational efficiency, and community engagement. This request is tailored to address evolving challenges and to empower the Alexandria Police Department to fulfill its commitment to serving and protecting the city of Alexandria and surrounding community. In addition to supporting efforts to create and maintain a safe, resilient community, funding will allow for additional transparency in conjunction with the Department’s use of body worn cameras and contribute to the City’s efforts to improve trust, credibility, and accountability between law enforcement and those in our community law enforcement engages with and polices.
